Selected papers will be presented in the seminar. A post-seminar publication of papers, too, is intended. Interested scholars may send their abstracts to the following addressee positively by 15.02.15. The seminar will have the following sections. The sender should mention the intended section for his/her paper-presentation while sending the abstract.

- II. **Characterization of Women in Epic and Purāṇas.**
- III. **Characterization of Women in Classical Sanskrit literature.**
- IV. **Characterization of Women in Sanskrit Narrative literature.**
- V. **Characterization of Women in Buddhist and Jaina literature.**
