

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY PRAGUE
(THE CZECH REPUBLIC)
and
UNIVERSITY OF CALCUTTA
(INDIA)

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made between:

Metropolitan University Prague (hereinafter referred as 'MUP'), one of the leading private universities in the Czech Republic, established with the registered address at Prokopova 100/16, 130 00 Praha 3, the Czech Republic, contact address: Dubecská 900/10, 100 31 Praha 10, Czech Republic,

and

University of Calcutta (hereinafter referred as 'CU'), a University established in 1857, in Kolkata, India. The address of University of Calcutta is Senate House, 87/1 College Street, Kolkata – 700 073, West Bengal, India.

MUP and CU are exchanging **this Memorandum of Understanding** to develop a spirit of amity between each other.

Therefore:

1. This agreement aims to promote international academic cooperation and the exchange of teaching and research experiences between MUP and CU.
2. The two universities will cooperate in developing friendship and mutual interests on a reciprocal basis of respect for the independence and equal status of each university.
3. The two universities agree to:
 - a. exchange academic materials and information;
 - b. mutually receive educational visits by faculty members and researchers;
 - c. hold joint international conferences;
 - d. promote faculty exchange and conduct joint research projects;
 - e. engage in other activities to better enhance mutual understanding and cooperation;
 - f. students and academic staff exchanges.
4. This agreement is effective from the date of signature by the duly authorized representatives of the two universities. The agreement may be revised with the consent of both universities, or terminated at the initiative of either university with a written notice of at least six months prior to the planned termination.
5. This agreement is executed in English only.

6. Any dispute or differences that may arise out of the terms and conditions of this agreement, shall be settled amicably through discussion or negotiation by the good offices of the Heads of the two institutions. The unresolved dispute may be referred to arbitration as per the applicable law of land.
7. Neither party will have any financial liability in executing the terms and conditions of this agreement.
